Executive Director Garza provided a brief summary on the prior JPA administration being relieved of duty in the middle of FY 2019-2020, and upon their departure failing to transfer any and all documents of the JPA despite numerous efforts of current JPA administration & general counsel to take possession of them, including agendas and minutes.

Per Board directive during the April 19 meeting of the Board, Mr. Garza then presented a resolution acknowledging the JPA's past administrative transition and related failure of its past administration to supply the JPA its material effects.

Secretary Farfan moved and Treasurer Sharif seconded to adopt Resolution No. 23-03.

 Consideration and request for approval of contract between the California Cities for Self-Reliance Joint Powers Authority and Gruber & Lopez, Inc for Financial Statements Auditing Services (As of and for the Years Ended June 30, 2021, 2022 and 2023).

Executive Director Garza provided a brief background regarding prior auditing firm experiences for JPA staff, and then presented proposals received from Gruber & Lopez, Inc to perform upcoming JPA financial audits, including their lengthy experience working with municipalities.

Secretary Farfan moved and Treasurer Sharif seconded to approve a contract with Gruber & Lopez, Inc for Financial Statements Auditing Services.

7. Consideration and possible action regarding FY 2023-2024 Annual Budget.

Mr. Garza presented the FY 2023-2024 proposed budget.

Mr. Garza noted that for prior Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget, the JPA experienced lower actuals in revenues in the amount of \$30,000 due to the unanticipated withdrawal of the Bicycle Casino's support and contribution. Due to this, the proposed FY 2023-2024 JPA budget reflects and overall reduction of \$7,500 in revenues, it anticipates ongoing overall annual cardroom support of \$70,000/yr, and proposes increases in member city dues of \$5,000 each, except for City of Cudahy whose increase would be \$2,500.

Mr. Garza then summarized proposed FY 2022-2023 budget and detailed staff's assessment and recommendations on how to invest resources and maximize return for the JPA, its members and partner cardrooms.

Proposal for a balanced budget for FY 2023-2024:

- 1) Balanced annual budget at \$227,500.
- 2) Increases in fees for member cities (\$157,500).
- 3) No increases in fees for cardrooms (\$70,000).
- 4) Expenses lowered (\$227,500).
- 5) <u>Board member stipends</u>: Increased by \$375 due to anticipated special board meetings that may arise regarding additional cardroom regulations.
- 6) Executive Director: no increase.
- 7) Operational Expenses: no increase.
- 8) <u>Legal Services</u>: Reduced by \$10,525/yr. Reflects actuals from last year as well anticipated legal activities that may arise regarding additional cardroom regulations.
- 9) <u>Financial Services</u>: Reduced by \$1,500/yr reflecting rate from new auditing firm.
- 10) Legislative Lobbying: no increase.
- 11) <u>Communications</u>: Increased by \$4,200 reflecting actuals for services provided.
- 12) <u>Contingency</u>: Remain at \$0, to ensure a lean and effective budget.


