WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9 (Meetings of the Board) of the Fourth Restated and Amended California Cities for Self-Reliance Joint Powers Authority ("Authority") Agreement, the location of meetings along with the date and hour of each meeting by the Board of the Authority, "may be fixed from time to time by resolution of the Board of Directors ("Board)";

WHEREAS, at the Regular Board Meeting on March 20, 2024, the Board adopted Resolution No. 24-01 updating the start time for all Regular Meetings held by the Authority to 8:30 AM;

WHEREAS, at the Regular Board Meeting on April 17, 2024, the Board adopted Resolution No. 24-02 updating the start time for all Regular Meetings held by the Authority to 12:30 PM;

SECTION 4. The Chair or designee of the Joint Powers Authority are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and shall be effective until the Joint Powers Authority adopts a resolution voiding the current action, all previous resolutions concerning the start time and weekly day of Regular Meetings are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 6. All portions of this Resolution are severable. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

SECTION 7. That the Chair shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and that the same shall be in full force and effect.
