3. <u>Status update & report from California Advocacy, LLC with respect to legislative</u> <u>matters.</u>

Mr, Marvin Pineda provided a comprehensive report on the ongoing process of the Bureau of Gambling Control Concept Regulations on Blackjack & Rotation Impacts. Initial comments by all stakeholders, including the JPA, JPA member cities and cardrooms were submitted by Thursday October 26. Its public vetting and review process will take approximately two years starting with a initial draft public scoping review that will include an impact analysis. After comprehensive assessment, JPA and JPA member cities comments to Attorney General Bonta focused on the need for an inclusive process, need for the Bureau to ensure it performs a wide-ranging and comprehensive impact analysis that includes those to cities, communities and residents, and a reminder of the anticipated yet preventable devastation these proposed regulations will have on our JPA member cities and surrounding communities..

He also reported on SB 549 (Newman) and its status as a 2-year bill available to be reconsidered next year. Specifically, there will be an anti-SB 549 Rally Day in Sacramento on January 9. Lastly, he noted that while not yet confirmed, there exists a possibility that a new, SB-549-type bill may be introduced by another member of the legislature.

Lastly on stakeholder engagement, Mr. Pineda requested support on the gathering of letters of engagement from JPA City-based local community groups who benefit from local revenues realized by cardrooms.
